A) QMH- a local resident has raised concerns about the lack of a fully functioning hospital (QMH). They seek assistance to start a petition and communicate this issue to Fife Council and the Scottish Government. Another local resident has agreed to help kickstart this project.

B) Sewage leak- A local resident had expressed concerns regarding a sewage leak on alexander street, this will be addressed with the relevant departments.

C) Neighbour Issues.

A local resident expressed their concerns regarding a social media post regarding the street they reside in. This post was deemed untrue about some children playing in the street stating they are damaging cars etc, Blair drive has a neighbourhood watch programme and no one has reported any wrongdoing.

D) drug dealing issue

A local resident had reported what looked like a drug deal happening on the roundabout of Pilmuir street/ Arthur street, Headwell CC has sent a report to the Community police to keep an eye on this area as it is a new place of concern.
