Pavemenet parking Ban

Please see attached response from CLLR Auxi.

- “Pavement Parking Ban. The Council is still working on some exemptions, although they have already met with the Councillors of Dunfermline to discuss the streets that have been raised with us by residents. I would expect they will share the finalised list of exempted roads once consultations with elected members are complete. In the meantime, the streets highlighted to them for potential exemption will remain exempt until a final decision is reached. Drivers

must also ensure that if they park on the pavement, they leave 1.5m of space for pedestrians. We have been advised that parking markings and signage will take a few years to be put in place.

During our meeting with Transportation to discuss the Pavement Parking Ban, I highlighted the large area of pavement at the junction of Pilmuir Street with Arthur Street/Headwell Road. I raised concerns about the number of vehicles parked on that corner, while acknowledging that there is plenty of space to park. They agreed to ensure parking spaces are properly marked in this area to improve pedestrian safety, particularly for children going to school.”
