3. Matters Arising

A) Hedge at QAHS Hill

We previously discussed the need for the hedge at the QAHS hill to be cut back due to the dangerous obstruction it causes to drivers' visibility. Cutting it would significantly improve road safety in that area.

B) Report from FC Councillors to Submit to HCC if Absent

We have all discussed the ongoing issues within the HCC, but we still have not received any outcomes or feedback from the FC. It would be very beneficial if the Councillors could submit a report when they are unable to attend the monthly meetings.

C) Hill Street Junction

Members and the public have again raised concerns about the Hill Street junction. Unfortunately, we have still not received any updates or feedback on this matter.

D) Park Opening

This Saturday will mark the official opening of Headwell Play Park. There will be a fundraising stall, bouncy castles, cake and candy, and more. We hope to see everyone there to support this great cause.

E) Benches

VC enquired about repairing the benches in the play park. Unfortunately, this is not feasible at the moment as it would cost £200 per bench to replace the wood, totaling £400 for both benches, which we feel is too expensive.

F) Dog Park

We discussed inviting Stephen Duffy to assess how much land could be used and what the costs would be to create a dog park just behind Headwell Play Park.

G) Community Garden Update

Members raised concerns about the community gardens, which currently have a lot of weed growth. VC explained that the contractor has returned to address this, but the weeds continue to grow back. HCC has purchased strong weedkiller from a licensed supplier, who has applied it properly. A follow-up report will be provided.

H) Manhole on Arthur Street

A manhole on Arthur Street was spray-painted over three months ago but has still not been repaired. No further action has been taken to resolve this issue.
